is only one true God. The Egyptians worshiped a multitude of false gods, and the Lord used the plagues to prove that nothing worshiped in Egypt could save them from his demonstrative power.

This tutorial will explain the ten plagues and their order. This section concludes with seven fill-in-the-blank questions to test your knowledge of the ten plagues.

Plague 1: Water Turned into Blood

God turned water throughout Egypt into blood. Fish and river animals died, and the Nile River reeked. The account of the first plague is in Exodus 7:14-25.

Plague 2: Frogs

The Lord saturated the land of Egypt with an abundance of frogs. Later, in yet another display of his power, God supernaturally killed the frogs, filling Egypt with the stench of their death. The full account of the second plague is in Exodus 8:1-15.

Plague 3: Lice

God sent an infestation of the wingless, biting parasites known as lice. The infestation was so thick that, according to Exodus 8:17, "All the dust of the land became lice throughout all the land of Egypt." The full account is in Exodus 8:16-19.

Plague 4: Flies

God sent massive, intrusive swarms of flies upon Egypt. Flies covered the ground, harassed the people, and invaded all the Egyptian homes. To prove he was God alone and that this plague was only for Egyptians, no flies invaded Goshen, where God's people, the Israelites, lived. This account is in Exodus 8:20-32.

Plague 5: Death of Livestock

God killed Egypt's cattle, horses, donkeys, camels, oxen, and sheep during the fifth plague. No livestock of the Israelites died during this time. This plague is detailed in Exodus 9:1-7.

Plague 6: Boils

God sent the sixth plague to Egypt without any warning. The sixth plague resulted in festering boils and an incurable itch on all the Egyptians. The boils were so bad that Pharaoh's magicians could not stand before Moses. The account of this plague is in Exodus 9:8-12.

Plague 7: Hailstorm

God provided prior warning before unleashing the worst hailstorm in Egypt's existence. The entire account is in Exodus 9:13-34.

Plague 8: Locusts

God sent swarms of locusts into Egypt that were so dense the land became dark because of them. Yet no locusts intruded into Goshen, where the Israelites were safe from the infestation. The account is in Exodus 10:1-20.

Plague 9: Darkness

Darkness "which may be felt" covered Egypt for three days. The darkness was so intense that, according to Exodus 10:21-23, people could not see each other. The Israelites, however, enjoyed light as usual.

Plague 10: Death of All Firstborn

The firstborn of the Egyptian people and the firstborn of their beasts were slain in the tenth and final plague. All deaths occurred in a

single night. To show a clue to the identity of God's beloved Israelites, the Israelite dog would bark during this historically gruesome night. The account of this plague is in Exodus 11:1-8; 12:21-30.

Locusts that were so dense the land was covered. Locusts intruded into Goshen, the only place of infestation. The account is in Exodus 10:1-13.

Darkness

Darkness over Egypt for three days. The darkness was so thick that Exodus 10:21-23, people could not see. However, enjoyed light as usual.

Firstborn

Death of the firstborn of their beasts and of the firstborn of the Egyptians. All deaths occurred in a single night.
